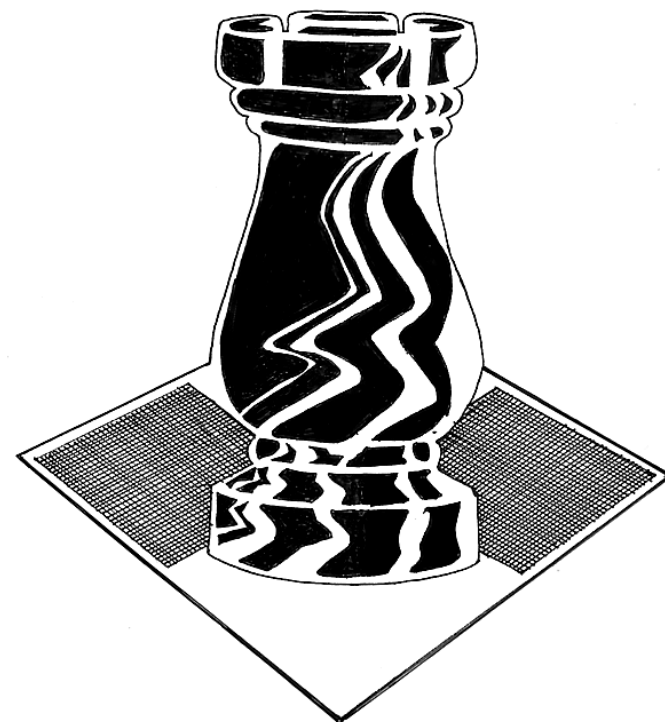
Travelling to the Latvian Club
