

4. The Chairman asked that the treasurer prepare invoices to be sent out by the end of March.
5. The Secretary reported that round 3 of the individual competitions had been postponed due to bad weather. As there was no spare date available in the calendar the competitions would now be decided over four rounds.
6. The outstanding postponed fixture between Clayton and Undercliffe B was discussed. All parties aired their views. The Chairman explained that it was up to the captains to agree a new date. But if the fixture was not played before 7 April then Undercliffe B would have to default the match.
7. Andy Wainwright submitted a schedule for the summer competitions to be posted on the website. He asked that funds be made available to purchase equipment for use at the tournament. The treasurer pointed out that this would set a precedent and that if other clubs then asked for funds it would pose problems for the Association. The Chairman stated that while the committee supported the proposals the request for funding would have to be considered further.
9. Andy Wainwright had submitted a formal complaint to the Secretary about an incident in a BDCA competition. At that point the Treasurer and Secretary had to leave so that the meeting was no longer quorate. The Chairman therefore adjourned the meeting. Andy Wainwright protested but the Chairman explained that no business could be transacted if the meeting was not quorate.

Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned at 9.00pm.
